## May 5th - Cinco de Mayo Luncheon - 12:00-3:00

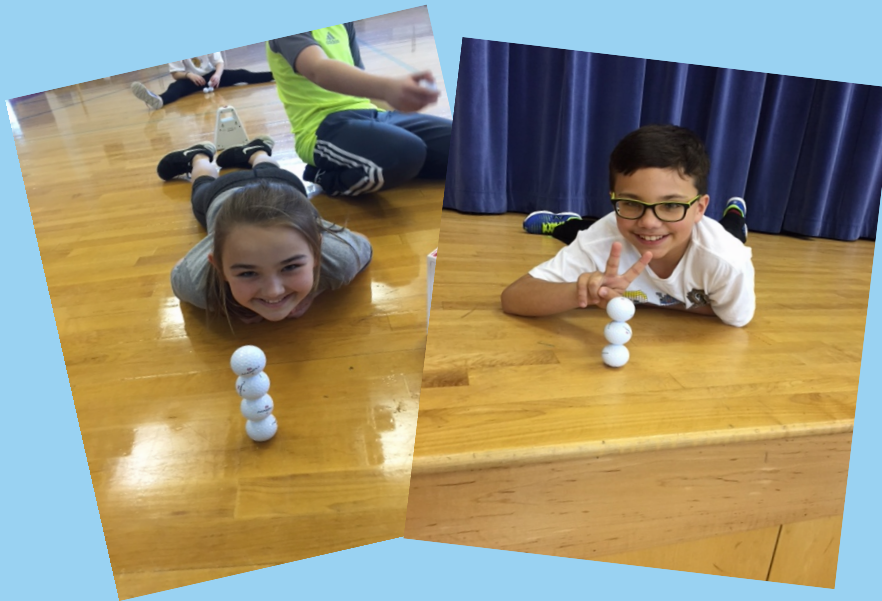
Mr. Terry's 8th Grade Financial Literacy Class participated in the Virtual Stock Market Game sponsored by SIFMA (Securities Industry and Financial Markets Association) and won 1st Place out of 296 teams in the Middle School Division. They aggressively turned \$100,000 into \$121,530.04 in a three-month span earning close to a 16 percent gain on their initial investment. Students worked as a team to find stocks, track their progress, predict patterns, and trade based on current market prices. "We took advantage of what was going on worldwide with oil being the cheapest it's been in many years. There is no way oil can stay at those prices forever. We researched oil companies and followed their financial patterns to decide as a team where we wanted to invest our money. It really paid off, as that's where we made our largest returns," said Connor Schiela.
